The only written coverage was a one by two inch column, buried in the box scores, listing only overall winners. Maybe some letters to the editor would help; after all, how many local sporting events can boast that they have 600 or more competitors!

Plans are well underway for the G.R.T.C. Annual Banquet, to be held April 30th at the Burgundy Basin Inn. Please take the time to make some awards nominations when you send in your reservation. Also, Tim McAvinney still needs slides and photos to be used during the banquet.

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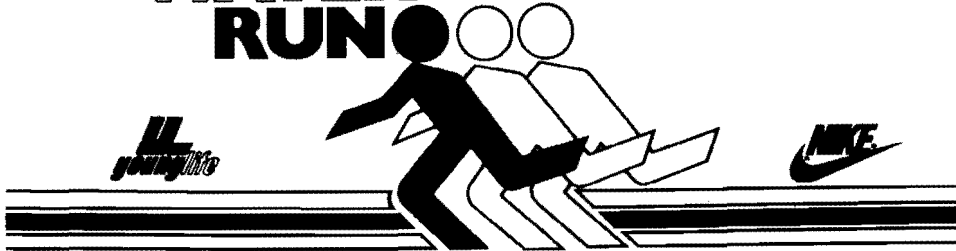

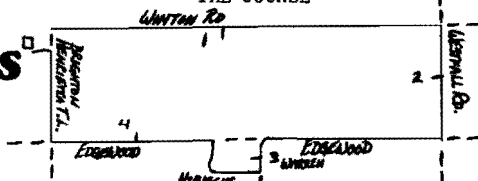
